

INTRODUCTION

This case has been initiated in line with article 2 of practice directions on small claims court NO. 2 of Bauchi state 2022, where the claimant cause a letter of demand as in form SCA 1, thereafter summons were issued and served on the defendant as in form SCA 3 in accordance to Article 2 (3) by the bailiff of this court in accordance to Article 5 (2). The affidavit of services in form SCA 6 dated 13/6/23 has been deposed to by the bailiff of this Hon. court

BRIEF FACTS OF THE CASE

The claimant aver that he bought provisions material worth N100,000.00 only to the defendant as loan on conditions that the defendant will upset the loan with interest of N30,000.00 by installment payment to the tune of N9,750.00 only every week up to final liquidation of loan, now he paid N70,000.00 only remain the outstanding balance of N47,000.00 only, he pray for the following reliefs: -

A) An order against the defendant to pay the outstanding balance of N47,000.00 only

B) An order against the defendant to pay the sum of N2,500.00 only as damage and cost of this action N5,500.00 only

During pretrial conference defendant admit liability consequent upon which the claimant urged the court to enter judgment against him

DECISION

It has been a long time practice which authorities need not to be cited, to the effect that admitted facts require no further proof, the court will decide a matter base on the admission of the defendant as capsulated in section 123 of the evidence act 2011 as amended and the case of MR KWASI KARI KARI ADUSEI & ANOR VS MR TOYIN ADEBAYO (2012) LPELR-7844 SC

In the light of the above I hereby enter judgment against the defendant in favor of plaintiff as per his claim in originating process and grant all the reliefs as prayed.

This case is decided today being 15/6/23 there is right of appeal to High Court Bauchi within 14 days by the aggrieved party
