

JUDGEMENT

The claimant commenced this suit under the Bauchi state practice direction on Small Claim Court No 2 of 2022, she filled and filled form SCA 2 and 3 dated 29th day of December 2025, the claimant claim against the defendant is the sum of ₦500,000 (Five Hundred Thousand Naira) and ₦50,000 (Fifty Thousand Naira) as cost of action.

On the date slated for hearing the defendant admitted to the claimant claim before the court.

COURT – In Nigeria law, the principal facts admitted need not be proved means that if a party to a case explicitly admits a fact in their pleadings or during proceedings as in the case at hand the court indeed this court accepts it as established, and the opposing party doesn't need to present evidence to prove it.

In line of the above judgment is hereby entered in favor of the claimant against the defendant as per her claim and reliefs.


