

The defendant in this suit have been duly served with the originating process of the court as required by law as evidence by affidavit of service dated 29TH day of October, 2025 deposed to by the bailiff of this Honorable Court one ABDULSALAM ABDULLAHI.


The defendant was before this court on the last adjourned date and he was aware of todays date but chosen not to be in court. This court would proceed in the absence of the defendant pursuant to article 8(2) of the Practice Direction on Small Claims Court N0.2 of the 2002 of Bauchi State.


The principles of haring demand that an opportunity shall be given to a party to utilize the opportunity according to him.

The application made by the claimant are granted as follows;

- a. The disputed sum of N60,000.00 waved and abandoned and not part of the claim in this suit.
- b. The defendant/judgment debtor is ordered to pay the claimant the sum of N30,000.00 only as cost of this action. Now the judgment debtor shall pay the total sum of N27,000.00 to the claimant in this suit.
- c. The application made by the judgement debtor for installmental payment of N20,000.00 monthly is hereby refused.

There is right to appeal to the High Court of Justice Bauchi within 14 days as provided by the Practice Direction on Small Claims Court No2 of 2022 of Bauchi State, if the judgement debtor is aggrieved with this judgement.
