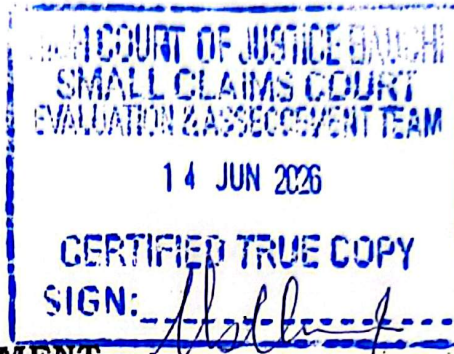

JUDGMENT
