JUDGMENT/ORDER

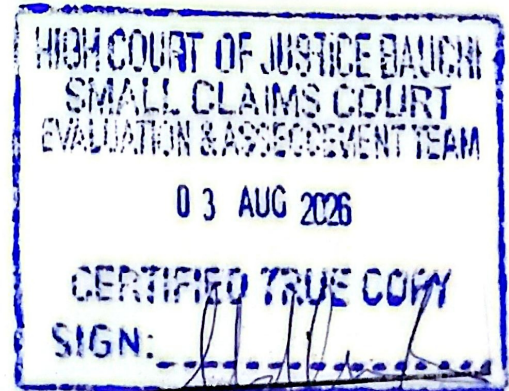
The originating processes were duly served on the Defendant on, as evidenced by the Proof of Service contained in the Court's record.

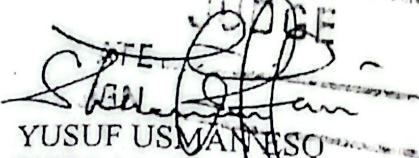
Accordingly, judgment is hereby entered in favour of the Claimant against the Defendant.

6. This shall be the judgment of the Court.

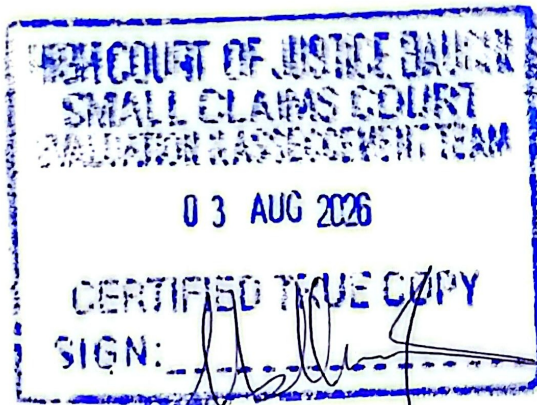

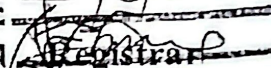
